2. New Business

• Terry Stockwell reported that he has officially taken over as Harbor Master from Corning Townsend at the end of this summer. He has toured all three rivers and noted the moorings, many of which are empty. He would like to assure that all residents with easements or RoW to these rivers have access to a mooring. He would like to maintain a friendly, low-key, fun presence on Edgecomb's waterfront. He would like to find out who owns which moorings and which are available. Sixteen new permits were issued, five for aqua-culture businesses on the Damariscotta. Terry will contact several individuals to invite them to join the Waterfront Committee, and he will report back to the SB about whom to appoint. He has been asked to install a No Wake buoy in the area of Oven's Mouth.

3. Ongoing Business

Protection from harassment update: Dawn reported that there is a temporary
restraining order (with no contact requirement) on an individual who has been
harassing and threatening the SB and his neighbors regarding his access to a
roadway near his property. There will be a court hearing for a longterm restraining
order on Nov. 2. The Attorney General instructed Dawn to finish any FOAA work
and bring it to the Nov 2 hearing.
