Notes from the Schmid Preserve Advisory Board Meeting
February 20, 2019, 7 p.m., Town Hall

1. Call to Order

Bob Leone, Laura Lubelczyk and Lisa McSwain were present, which did not constitute a quorum. Mike Smith and Janet Blevins were also present.

a. Review of Meeting Minutes: A correction was made to the budget figures: \$150 was added in for road maintenance and under 5.a.5, butternut was deleted, and bittersweet added.

If ready, the acquisition could be approved at Town Meeting; however, Bob Leone did not think that would be possible.

b. Gravel Purchase: Bob Leone said a roll of fabric 12-1/2' x 432' would cost \$440 at Ames. A total of \$860 is available for the gravel purchase, using this and last year's funds. Leone will check with Eric Wood for his price. Joe McSwain will spread the gravel.
